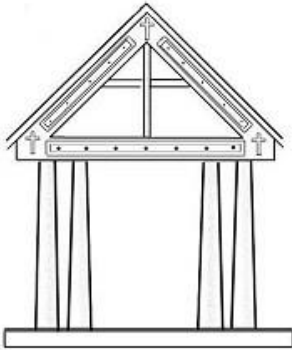


Getting on PAR

What is PAR?

PAR is Pre-Authorized Remittance, or direct debit, of donations from the account of the donor to that of the church. The funds are transferred electronically on the 20th (or next business day) of each month.

Benefits to donor

- 1 Ensures regularity of support to CCBC throughout the year.
- 2 Avoids need to “catch up” after having been away.
- 3 Eliminates need for (and cost of) writing frequent cheques.

Benefits to CCBC

1. Provides regular, dependable flow of donations for ministry support.
2. Eases counting of weekly collection.
3. Reduces bookkeeping, paper work.
4. Reduces cheque handling and other bank charges.

How to get on PAR?

1. Decide the amount of your monthly PAR offering.
2. Fill in the PAR Authorization Form on the reverse side of this pamphlet.
3. Note that the option exists to donate by bank account debit or by credit card debit (if choosing the former, remember to attach a cheque marked “VOID”).
4. Insert and seal in an envelope marked “PAR”, and place on the offertory plate or mail / hand in to the church office.

Who is CCBC’s PAR service provider?

The United Church of Canada provides CCBC’s PAR service, as it does for many Anglican churches in Ottawa and across Canada. The Anglican Church of Canada does not offer this service.

What is the PAR fee?

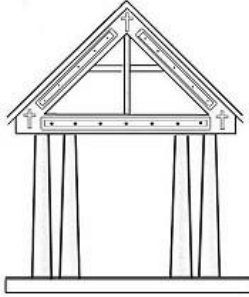
The United Church of Canada charges parishes (NOT the donor) 50¢ per debit or, over the course of a year, \$6.00 per PAR donor. This fee is less than that charged by commercial financial institutions for the same service. Once the number of donors exceeds 90 in a parish, no further fee is charged to that parish regardless of how many PAR donors beyond 90 there are.

When does PAR start?

The United Church of Canada can start a PAR service on the 20th (or next business day) of a given month if it receives a valid PAR Authorization Form by the 10th day of that month. Otherwise the service will start on the 20th of the following month.

What happens if there are not sufficient funds in the debit account?

The United Church will cease to attempt further debits from such accounts until the Parish PAR Contact Person has advised that the donor has rectified the situation. In these cases the donor might wish to make a donation to CCBC for the amount associated with the month(s) in which no debit was made.
